





KINGDOM COMMANDS

21 Wherever your treasure is, there the desires of your *heart* will also be. **Matthew 6:21**




T1 DO NOT CHASE SUCCESS.







T3 BE RICH TOWARDS GOD.


Luke 12:16-21




16 Then he told them a story: “A rich man had a fertile farm that produced fine crops. **17** He said to himself, ‘What should I do? I don’t have room for all my crops.’ **Luke 12:16-17**



18 Then he said, 'I know! I'll tear down my barns and **build** bigger ones. Then I'll have **room** enough to store all my wheat and other goods. **Luke 12:18**



19 And I'll sit back and say to myself, "My friend, you have enough stored away for years to come. Now take it easy! Eat, drink, and be merry!" **Luke 12:19**



20 But God said to him, ‘You fool! You will die this very night. Then who will get *everything* you worked for?’ **21** “Yes, a person is a fool to store up earthly wealth but not have a rich *relationship* with God.” **Luke 12:20-21**
