1 So now there is no condemnation for those who belong to Christ Jesus. **2** And because you belong to him, the power of the life-giving Spirit has freed you from the power of sin that leads to death. **3** The law of Moses was unable to save us because of the weakness of our sinful nature. So God did what the law could not do.

3 He sent his own Son in a body like the bodies we sinners have. T3 SPIRITUAL CONVICTION LEADS TO JOY. *Psalms 51:1-10*





1 Have mercy on me, O God, because of your unfailing love. Because of your great compassion, blot out the stain of my sins. **2** Wash me clean from my guilt. Purify me from my sin. **3** For I recognize my rebellion; **it haunts me day and night.**

4 Against you, and you alone, have I sinned; I have done what is evil in your sight. You will be proved right in what you say, and your judgment against me is just. **5** For I was born a sinner—yes, from the moment my mother conceived me. **6** But you desire honesty from the womb, teaching me wisdom even there.

7 Purify me from my sins, and I will be clean; **wash me**, and I will be whiter than snow. **8 Oh, give me back my joy again;** you have broken me—now let me rejoice. **9 Don't keep looking at my sins. Remove the stain of my guilt.** **10 Create in me a clean heart, O God. Renew a loyal spirit within me.**
