
**T1 THE SPIRIT TRANSFORMS OUR DNA.**

***Acts 2:36-41***




**36** “So let everyone in Israel know for certain that **God has made this Jesus, whom you crucified, to be both Lord and Messiah!**” **37** *Peter’s words pierced their hearts,* and they said to him and to the other apostles, “Brothers, what should we do?”

***Acts 2:36-37***



**38** Peter replied, “Each of you must **repent of your sins** and **turn to God** and **be baptized** in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins. Then **you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.** **39** This promise is to you, to your children, and to those far away—all who have been called by the Lord our God.”

**40** Then Peter continued preaching for a long time, strongly urging all his listeners, “**Save yourselves from this crooked generation!**” **41** *Those who believed what Peter said were baptized and added to the church that day—about 3,000 in all.*

*Galatians 5:19-26*




**19** *When you follow the desires of your sinful nature, the results are very clear:* sexual immorality, impurity, lustful pleasures, **20** idolatry, sorcery, hostility, quarreling, jealousy, outbursts of anger, selfish ambition, dissension, division, **21** envy, drunkenness, wild parties, and other sins like these. Let me tell you again, as I have before, that **anyone living that sort of life will not inherit the Kingdom of God.** *Galatians 5:19-21*



**22** *But the Holy Spirit produces this kind of fruit in our lives:* love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, **23** gentleness, and self-control. There is no law against these things!

***Galatians 5:22-23***




**24** Those who belong to Christ Jesus have nailed the passions and desires of their sinful nature to his cross and crucified them there. **25** Since we are living by the Spirit, **let us follow the Spirit's leading in every part of our lives.** **26** Let us not become conceited, or provoke one another, or be jealous of one another.


**T3 THE SPIRIT IS PART

*John 15:1-8*




**1** “I am the Vine, and my Father is the gardener. **2** He cuts off every branch of mine that doesn’t produce fruit, and he prunes the branches that do bear fruit *so they will produce even more.*

*John 15:1-2*




**3** You have already been pruned and purified by the message I have given you. **4** **Remain in me**, and **I will remain in you**. For a branch cannot produce fruit if it is severed from the vine, and you cannot be fruitful unless you remain in me.

***John 15:3-4***



**5** “Yes, I am the vine; you are the branches. **Those who remain in me, and I in them, will produce much fruit.** For apart from me you can do nothing. **6** Anyone who does not remain in me is thrown away like a useless branch and withers. *Such branches are gathered into a pile to be burned.*

*John 15:5-6*



**7** But if you remain in me and my words remain in you, you may ask for anything you want, and it will be granted! **8** When you produce much fruit, you are my true disciples. *This brings great glory to my Father.*  
*John 15:7-8*
